- ✓ Eight (8) years of directly related operating experience in a high voltage electric system, including **four (4) years supervising others**;
- ✓ Valid Class 5 Alberta Driver's License with acceptable driving record;
- ✓ An equivalent combination of management approved training and education may be considered.
